



Angiographic Factors

- Thrombus
- Eccentric
- Irregular Contour
- Proximal vessel tortuosity
- Calcification
- Chronic total occlusion
- Ostial
- Diffuse disease
- Degenerated vein graft




Procedural View




Balloon Dilatation

- Fix the guidewire in place
- Advance the balloon
- Confirm accurate placement through contrast injections delivered via the guide
- Utilize calloon markers for placement
- Inflate the balloon using an inflation device containing a 50:50 solution of contrast & saline.









The stent is introduced into the blood vessel on a balloon catheter

The balleon is inflated, causing the stemblo expland and press against the resset wall

Once the balloon is withdrawn, the stent stays in place permanently, holding the vessel open and improving the flow of blood
